In addition to my teaching responsibilities, I have created, modified and proposed numerous courses that are currently being offered at SUNY Farmingdale and Hofstra University. I have also served on promotions, curriculum, orientation, and search, executive, and screening committees. I have given lectures on several topics for various on and off campus organizations.

**RESEARCH EXPERIENCE:**

1973-1975 Studied the effects of a choice situation on rats. Work was completed under the supervision of Drs. Howard Racklin and John Bransford (SUNY Stony Brook, Dept. of Psychology). In 1972, under the supervision of Dr. James Geer, studied the effects of neuter vs. clinical sex words on men and women. Also, under the supervision of Dr. Geer (SUNY Stony Brook, Dept. of Psychology), studied the vasocongestive vaginal response in women during masturbation. This study was useful in establishing plethysmography as a clinical indicator of orgasm in women. This work culminated in my Master's Thesis in Psychology. Also, on my committee were Drs. John Neale and John Gagnon.

Research Assistant to Dr. John Neale (SUNY Stony Brook, Dept. of Psychology). The goal of this study was to select for study children who were especially vulnerable to schizophrenia. Tests administered were: Current and Past Psychopathology Scales (CAPPS), MMPI, and Psychiatric Rating Scales.

Research Assistant to Dr. Marvin Goldfried (SUNY Stony Brook, Dept. of Psychology). Work involved researching behavior modification studies in the following areas: obesity, smoking, and migraine headaches.

Research Assistant to Dr. Richard Green (SUNY Stony Brook, Dept. of Psychiatry). The project, entitled The Psychosexual Development of the Blind, consisted of extensive interviewing of congenitally and adventitiously blind persons about their family life and taking a developmental history, questioning them about sexuality.

1975-1981 During the time spent in the Doctoral program at SUNY Stony Brook, I was involved in various research projects. For example, I examined self-esteem levels in men and women after divorce. This work was completed under the direction of Dr. Eugene Weinstein. Also, under his direction, I studied happiness and the working mother. This work involved a quantitative secondary analysis of a NORC data set examining the correlation between working mothers and reported levels of happiness. Studied the social structural effects of the new sexuality under the supervision of Dr. John Gagnon. This work involved an evaluation of Durkheimian theory in reference to the consequences of the new or multiple morality patterns existing in contemporary society.

Also, under the direction of Dr. John Gagnon, examined the relation between parental control and sexual promiscuity. This involved a secondary analysis of a NORC data set. Under the supervision of Drs. John Gagnon, Hanan Selvin, Eugene Weinstein, Judith Tanur and James Geer, I completed my doctoral dissertation, *The Role of Masturbation in Socio-Sexual Development*. This work involved a secondary analysis of a NORC data set.

1982-1990. Premenstrual Mood Changes: Implications for Couple Therapy. This research was on premenstrual syndrome and its effects on interpersonal relations. This research was presented at various conferences and has culminated in the publication of several journal articles.

Children of Divorce: This research involved survey questionnaire and analysis examining the long-term effects of divorce. It also investigated the perceived efficacy of peer counseling in divorcing situations. This research culminated in the development of the P.E.A.C.E. training manual, the P.E.A.C.E. booklet journal articles, paper presentations and the beginning development of a school-based intervention program for children of divorce.

AIDS: Has It Changed the Behavior of College Students? This research investigated the effects of AIDS on college student's sexual behavior. It involved the analysis and use of questionnaire data. Papers for publication and presentation of professional papers are listed.

Need for Family Counseling in the Schools: Research involved the analysis of questionnaire data examining the need for family counseling in the school system with the possibility of creating a feedback situation between family counseling centers and the guidance offices, psychologists, special education departments and/or the possibilities of training school-based personnel in family counseling.

**CURRENT RESEARCH:**

**The L.I.F.E. Program: Developer.** This program involves teaching students (K-12) how to name, communicate, and resolve feelings. It is a school-based program that utilizes age appropriate communication skill building.

**P.E.A.C.E. Program: CO-Developer.** This program involves the development, establishment, training, evaluation and implementation of three educational seminars for persons going through the divorce process. Educational information and materials are provided about the legal aspects of divorce, the emotional aspects of divorce for adults, and for children. P.E.A.C.E. Program establishes the basis for Law Reform in NYS around divorce. To date have trained over 300 mental health professionals all over NYS, coordinated and presented at two major P.E.A.C.E. conferences, assisted in the writing of a judicial grant, serve on the NYS executive P.E.A.C.E. committee and the Nassau County P.E.A.C.E. steering committee.

**Levels of Intimacy and Marital Satisfaction:** This study examines the relation between reported intimacy levels and marital satisfaction. The data for this study are in process of being collected. Thus far, approximately 60 surveys have been returned from couples.

**Differentiation of Self:** This study involves the examination of a basic belief in Couple Therapy Theory - that individuals of similar levels of differentiation of self (psychological maturity) marry. It involves the analysis of data gathered around couple psychological adjustment and examines the impact of certain demographic variables on mate selection processes. Awarded, ACA Research Grant.

**Attitudes About Single Parents and Children of Divorce:** This study involves an investigation into the attitudes of educators and mental health professionals about single parents and children of divorce and the development of a model which will assist them in examining their biases.

**Resolving Anger Through Communication.** This is a program evaluation of anger management. It involves pre-test and post-test of a 10-session anger management group.

**Couples and Finance:** This is a major research project investigating levels of differentiation of self and couples, levels of self esteem and couple's reported marital satisfaction, and couples' financial behavior as a metaphor for marital dynamics. This research is in collaboration with Carmine Calabro, SUNY Stony Brook.
